- Regularly reviewing the policy and updating of systems and procedures.
- Following a systematic approach to Occupational Health & Safety management plan to achieve continual performance improvement.
- Empowering employees to report any health or safety hazard that they may spot, or incidences where health and safety guidelines are not followed.
- Training and validating employees and contractors on Occupational Health and safety practices.
- Conducting all work in a safe manner and to ensure integrity of the assets, by providing personal protective equipment, tools and tackles.

- Investigating all incidents relating to Occupational Health and Safety including minor ones and near misses, followed by implementation of corrective actions.

- Identifying and evaluating Occupational Health risks related to operations and carrying out pre-employment and periodic medical check-ups for its employees.
- Implementing programs and appropriate protective measures to control such risks.
- Keeping abreast of latest international codes, standards and practices and adopting the same where applicable.
- Periodically auditing our Occupational Health & Safety practices.
- Monitoring progress against targets and adopting reporting practices in line with national and internationally recognized guidelines
